Question:

With so many requirements how do I start with my safety program?

Answer:

In today's work environment, there are many resources available to safety and non-safety professionals to aid in the development and implementation of a strong safety and health management program. This is especially true for small businesses who may not have a full time Safety and Health Manger or team working for them. One of the first steps I recommend for an employer is to contact their local Ohio BWC office for a consultation with their assigned Safety Consultant. Additionally, the United Sates Department of Labor has a website that is a wealth of knowledge and examples to aid you in your program development. At https://www.osha.gov/ shpguidelines/index.html you can find step by step instructions, goals and support documents to help you implement a strong safety and health program. You can also access OSHA's Small Business Handbook (https:// www.osha.gov/Publications/smallbusiness/smallbusiness.pdf) which provides checklists for small businesses to identify what safety concerns currently exist. If you are looking for additional examples, toolbox talks, publications and videos to support your program efforts you can also utilize the Ohio BWC's library (https:// www.bwc.ohio.gov/employer/services/SandH/ Library.asp).
